

GOLDEN STATE TEACHER GRANT PROGRAM

The California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) is awarding up to \$20,000 for students who are currently enrolled in a teacher preparation program to earn a preliminary credential and commit to teaching at a California priority school in a high-need field for four years within five years after completing their teacher preparation program

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

- Students with a submitted Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or CA Dream Act Application (CADAA)
- Students currently enrolled in a teacher preparation program (including teacher resident and intern programs) based in California, approved by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC)
- Students working toward a preliminary teaching credential

HIGH-NEED FIELDS

- ► Bilingual Education
- Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM)
- Multiple Subject Instruction
- Special Education
- ► Transitional Kindergarten
- Other subjects as designated annually by the CTC
